

“DP SMART” HOBBY REGULATION

Article 1

(Object and scope)

1. The present regulation defines the rules applied to the “DP Smart” Hobby.
2. This Hobby aims to raffle Millennium BIM private Customers who constitute the “DP Smart” term application during the period between July 27th and December 22nd, 2022, under the terms established in the 2nd article of this Regulation.
3. DP Smart is a 180 days term application made available to private and Corporate Customers, with competitive interest rates, available for constitution in Smart IZI app and *Mobile Banking* channel.
4. Millennium BIM is the institution responsible for organizing the hobby.
5. When taking part in this hobby, all participants are subject to the present Regulation, whose interpretation, in case of doubt, will be made by the Jury indicated in the terms of 6th article.

Article 2

(Eligibility conditions)

1. All Millennium BIM Private Customers who constitute the term application “DP Smart” during the period between July 27th and December 22nd, 2022 are eligible for this raffle, under the terms established in the 2nd article of this Regulation.
2. Once the conditions referred to in the previous numbers of this article are ensured, the Customer increases the chances of being drawn the greater the amount invested, which is, for every 5,000 MZN (five thousand metical) of the amount applied, the Customer has one more chance to be drawn.
3. Employees of Millennium BIM, as well as those Customers under eighteen years of age on the date of constitution of the term application, are not eligible for this hobby.

Article 3

(Awards and their attribution)

1. In this campaign, 3 (three) Customers who constitute the term application under the conditions referred to in the previous article, in the global amount of 55,000.00 MZN (fifty five thousand metical), in the following terms:
 - a. 1st place - 30,000 MZN (thirty thousand metical);
 - b. 2nd place - 15,000 MZN (fifteen thousand metical);
 - c. 3rd place - 10,000 MZN (ten thousand metical).
2. The winners will be drawn at the end of the campaign, scheduled for the 23rd of December, 2022.
3. In case of impossibility of carrying out the raffle on the date mentioned in the previous point, the procedure will be ensured until 18:00 (18:00 hours) of the following business day.

Article 4

(Personal data and authorizations)

By participating in the hobby, participants expressly consent to the processing and computer processing of their personal data by Millennium BIM.

Article 5

(Raffle)

1. The raffle will be carried out through the random choice of eligible Customers from an electronic list that will include all Customers qualified according with the conditions of the contest.
2. The listing will be carried out automatically by a specific “Software” for this purpose, which will identify the CIF (Customer identification number at the Bank) and will be registered, producing a minutes of the raffle sequentially according to the order of extraction.

3. After the extraction of the draws, two copies of the minutes of the draw will be printed, which will be signed by the members of the jury.

Article 6

(Jury)

1. The Jury is composed of elements indicated by Millennium BIM and the inspector of the General Inspection of Games, who will take part in the awarding of the hobby.
2. In the event of a dispute, the decision of the hobby jury is binding on all aspects of the competition.

Article 7

(Hobby supervision)

At the end of the hobby, Millennium BIM will present to the General Inspection of Games a letter attaching the list of winners for supervision purposes.

Article 8

(Final dispositions)

1. All information relating to the hobby and publication in promotional materials are part of the rules and conditions of the hobby.
2. Hobby winners claim the prize at any BIM branch within a maximum period of 30 days from the date of the raffle.
3. The prizes will be paid by crediting the account held by the Customer with Millennium BIM.
4. These regulations will be published on the Millennium BIM website and other Millennium BIM platforms for consultation by participants.
